**Re: Information Request from Operating Engineers' Pension Plan**

Thank you for your undated letter, which we received on July 4, 2000, concerning your request for information from the Operating Engineers' Pension Plan.

The *Pension Benefits Standards Act (PBSA)* states that a member of a pension plan may view certain documents related to the pension plan. The administrator must allow the member to view, among other things, the financial statements of the pension fund within 10 days of receipt of a written request. The administrator is not required to allow a plan member to view financial statements of any particular investment, although the administrator may do so if they so wish.

The PBSA does not require the administrator to provide copies or extracts of documents to plan members, although, as stated above, the administrator may do so if they so wish.

With respect to the fourth item of your letter I can tell you the plan is registered under the PBSA.
